DYNAMIC FRENCH OPEN 2008

TONY DRAGO WINS SEASON-OPENER IN PARIS





Winner Tony Drago

> Three times former snookerstar Tony Drago had reached a Euro-Tour championship match within the last few years and three times it has been his respective opponent who cashed in the title in the end. But at the Dynamic French Open 2008, the Maltese finally broke the spell and secured his very first Euro-Tour title with a coming-frombehind 10-6 win over German Christian Reimering. Indeed, it was not only trailing 1-4 and 3-5 in this match what might stretched Drago's nerves. Despite several comfortable wins like the 10-3 successes over Carlos Cabello (ESP), Thomas Engert

(GER) and Markus Juva(FIN), he also had to survive three nervewracking 10-9 matches on his way to the title-match. In two of them he further more trailed seemingly pre-decisive. But neither young Polish Mateusz Sniegocki nor German Jakob Belka brought their leads of 9-7 respectively 9-6 over the line. But perhaps it were these experiences that might have helped him in the title-match later on. Beside Drago successfully ending his "losing-streak" in title-matches, it were Markus Juva (FIN) and Marco Tschudi from Switzerland who set marks in this tournament. Whereas former Euro-Tour Champion Juva reached his second podium after having won the tourstop of Rankweil in 2005, Tschudi entered his second semi-final after the Italy Open 2007. In the overall rankings, Mark Gray defended his pole position despite a 3-10 loss against Dutch star Niels Feijen in the round of the Last 32. New runner-up is Christian Reimering, whose final appearance brought him from No. 13 to now No. 2. Closely behind follows Italian veteran Bruno Muratore, who had succeeded in the conclusive tour-stop in 2007 and improved from No. 4 through his 9th

place in France. Dynamic French

As displayed in a separate press-release, the long-thermed cooperation between Euro-Tour organizer IBPF and media-partner Kozoom came to an end during the Dynamic French Open. This step turned out to be unavoidable as main intentions of both parties diverged evidently. "It is always sad when cooperations like these come to an end but these things happen on a daily basis in the business world", so IBPF President David Morris. Indeed, the IBPF

won't spare neither trouble nor expense to provide a further development also regarding the media-presence of the Euro-Tour. For that purpose, the IBPF has reacted immediately and meanwhile already found a satisfying solution for the upcoming tour-stops with another provider.

EURO-TOUR SPOTS FOR 9-BALL WC 2008 AFTER ITALY

The EPBF-spots for this year's World Pool Championship will be distributed after the Dynamic Italy Open 2008, the upcoming tournament of the Euro-Tour 2008, scheduled from 10th to 12th April in Naples.

EURO-TOUR BACK IN FRANCE

After a pause of more than 13 years, the Euro-Tour came back to France to host the Dynamic French Open, the season's opening tournament in 2008. Led by European No. 25 Vincent Facquet not less than 44 players from the host-country entered the competition, which meant the numerically strongest contingent of all 34 represented countries in a competely booked-out field of 256 players. Indeed, none of these players managed to reach the final round of the Last 32, a remarkable proof for the outstanding importance of continuous matchpractice on the highest level.

DIAMOND 9 SERIES INFO

A lot of important revises have helped to further increase the standard of the EPBF Eurotour. What has been already successful in the past, was now further developed for the sake of pool billiards sports in general as the "Diamond 9 Series". Long-termed contracts with organizers onspot are the key-point. They help all involved parties like players, visitors, sponsors and media, to plan for their respective purposes. Additionally, the total prize-money was increased to now €40.000.


